Brigadier General Walter Hill (American Civil War Union Army) Brigadier General Walter Hill (October 5, 1826 – July 6, 1898) was a Union Army officer during the American Civil War. He served as the Adjutant General of the Department of California in the West, Adjutant General of the Department of Arkansas in the East, and as a general in the Union Army. Early life and career Walter Hill was born in Mississippi on October 5, 1826. He was the son of United States Senator David Hill of Mississippi and his wife, the former Elizabeth Morris. He received a classical education in Mississippi and graduated from the University of Mississippi in 1845. He became a lawyer and studied law under Mississippi Supreme Court Chief Justice Joseph M. Hinds. He settled in New York City and began studying to become a physician. He attended the New York Medical College and graduated in 1852. During this time, he was elected as a Republican to the 26th and 27th Congresses, serving from March 4, 1855 to March 3, 1859. After leaving Congress, he resumed his studies and became a graduate of the New York Academy of Medicine. He settled in Arkansas in 1860 and began practicing medicine in Little Rock. Civil War service When the Civil War broke out, Hill enlisted as a Confederate volunteer on June 27, 1861, as a private in the 1st Arkansas Infantry Regiment, a volunteer unit of the Confederate States Army. He was commissioned as a captain of the 2nd Arkansas Infantry Regiment on November 21, 1861, and promoted to major on February 1, 1862. After taking part in the Battle of Shiloh, Hill transferred to the 42nd Arkansas Infantry Regiment, where he was promoted to lieutenant colonel on March 18, 1863. Hill was appointed a brigadier general on August 1, 1863, and placed in charge of the District of Arkansas, comprising the state's southeast section. He fought with the District of Arkansas during the Camden Expedition, then returned to Little Rock. He was mustered out with the remainder of the regiment on July 23, 1864. After returning home, he resumed his medical practice. West Hill returned to California, where he was commissioned as an officer in the regular Union Army. He 82157476af
